

SHARING TREES WITH CHILDREN

Tahar Ben Jelloun

Everything that trees have taught Tahar Ben Jelloun, which he wants to share with the younger generations.

One day, when Tahar Ben Jelloun was in the sixth grade, his teacher invited him to plant a tree. He even gave it a name: Sahbi, my friend. This memory would leave its mark on the author, who turns trees into teachers in this wonderful book.

In these pages blending together the author's story, memories, and poems, we are enchanted by trees in turn. But they are increasingly threatened by the very creatures they protect. Deforestation, wildfires, storms, droughts: when a forest disappears, part of the Earth's memory goes up in smoke.

In an effort to combat these dangers, Tahar Ben Jelloun teaches us to observe, touch, and appreciate trees. And to never cease to be amazed by these silent friends.

In the author's words: "I wrote this little book for the younger generations because I knew they still have the open ears and ability to be amazed, which old oaks like ourselves have unfortunately lost. Now I see them in my mind's eye: autonomous, observant, hungry to learn, full of unparalleled fascination and wonder as they stand before a thuja or a beech or an acacia in the woods. I know that children can't help but love trees. It's up to them to convince their parents and teach them what they now know. It's up to them to read, touch, admire, and save. It's up to us to follow them along this path of leaves and bark."







These comic books depict two main characters: Tambouille (a little girl who does everything right) and Gribouille (a cat who does everything wrong) are under the nose of a small mouse



The time we spend on our phones consumes more and more available brain energy, while our children soak up the world around them at an incredible speed.

With humor and realism, this book illustrates the temporal duality between parents and children, along with the tension it imposes on daily life. We will recognize ourselves in this story's characters and admit that we've sometimes played "the bad role." And, in the end, the whole family joins together to share a moment that exists beyond time.







Gaël Faye's first solo album, Pili Pili sur un croissant au beurre, was released in 2013. One of the songs on the album really stood out: «L'ennui des après-midi sans fin» [The boredom of endless afternoons]. The lyrics told a story, conjuring up childhood images and memories, sowing the seeds for a picture book. Gaël Faye now tells the story for readers big and small.

In Gaël Faye's own words

«As a child, I was lucky enough to feel bored. There was no school in the afternoons and at home, no screens or televisions. So I had to learn to develop my imagination to come up with games and pastimes. I lived with my father and my little sister in an old red brick house built in the days of Belgian colonization. ... Outside, a vast garden ringed the house. It was planted with mango, guava, and papaya trees. But my absolute favorite was a gigantic fig tree with powerful roots, an impressive trunk, and branches so long that they covered practically the entire garden. My father was a herpetologist, a reptile specialist. All over the garden stood cages full of cobras, vipers, garter snakes, and pythons. We also had aviaries full of fluttering, shimmering birds ... In that gloriously colorful realm, my life slowly passed to the alternating rhythm of the dry and rainy seasons. Of those days without movement, my abiding memory is of a magical period when I crammed the strongbox of my imagination full. The boredom of my childhood afternoons was a journey where time belonged to me, a space where I wove immense dreams, a world with no beginning and no end, like a sentence that ends with three little dots...»






