On September 13th 2022, a young Iranian student, Mahsa Amini, was arrested by the religious police in Tehran. Her only crime was that she wasn't properly wearing the headscarf imposed on women by the Islamic Republic. Once at the police station she was beaten so badly she had to be taken to the hospital, where she fell into a deep coma. She died three days later. The plight of this 22-year-old woman raised a wave of unprecedented protests that soon spread to the whole country.

For the one-year anniversary of the movement, Marjane Satrapi has gathered the finest cartoonists and illustrators in Europe, the US and Iran. Together they show what couldn't be photographed or filmed because of censorship.



Climbing is a favorite sport and a way of life for many. For some, it's even a religion! Here, Catherine Destivelle, the first woman to win the *Piolets d'Or* award, and David Chambre, a specialist and author of reference works on the history of mountaineering, have come together to tell us the stories of the major twists and turns that have marked this fun and challenging activity.

We begin with first ascents in the European mountain ranges, from free climbing in the Dolomites to the free solo of Yosemite National Park's El Capitan, not to mention mastering Fontainebleau or the use of crash pads all the way to Finland. Then we move on to 2021, when climbing became an Olympic sport starting with Tokyo's Summer Olympics. In a word, the authors recount the evolution of climbing over the course of 300 years.







In 1990, **Catherine Destivelle** became the first woman to solo the 3 sides of the Alps in the wintertime. Thanks to this, she became her generation's most brilliant mountaineer. Director of Éditions du Mont-Blanc, she is also the author of *Rock Dancer [Danseuse de roc]* (Denoel, 1987) and *The Apprentice Mountaineer [L'apprenti alpiniste]* (Hachette Jeunesse, 1996).

David Chambre is a professional climber and a graduate of the Sorbonne in geography. He works with reviews and writes reference works on the history of climbing (*The 9th Degree [Le 9^e degré]*, Éditions du Mont-Blanc, 2015) and mountaineering (*High Mountains [Haute-Montagne]*, E MDB, 2019, *The Piolets d'Or [Les Piolets d'Or]*, E MDB, 2021).

The artist of over 30 books, **Laurent Bidot** is the author of *the Shroud [Le Linceul]* series as well as *After the Roundup [Après la rafle]* (Arènes BD), which won numerous awards, in particular the "Ordre National du Bleuet de France 2022" and the Children's Award in the Ministry of the Armed Forces' "Galons de la BD."



Alan Turing has a stutter, but he is a genius and a dreamer, and an Olympic-level marathoner. He runs while thinking, thinks while running. At barely 30 years old, the English services recruited him to join the mathematical combat team. Their mission was to intercept and decipher Nazi communications.

Alan Turing alone broke the secret codes of Enigma. Without him, the war may have dragged on for two more years. However, in 1952, he was disqualified because he was gay. Two years later, in 1954, he committed suicide.


However, this hero, who worked behind the scenes, never decoded the most difficult of enigmas: that of his own. In this comic book, Arnaud Delalande and Eric Liberge offer an emotion-filled story of unrequited love, his missions, his differences, his solitude and his quest for identity.
